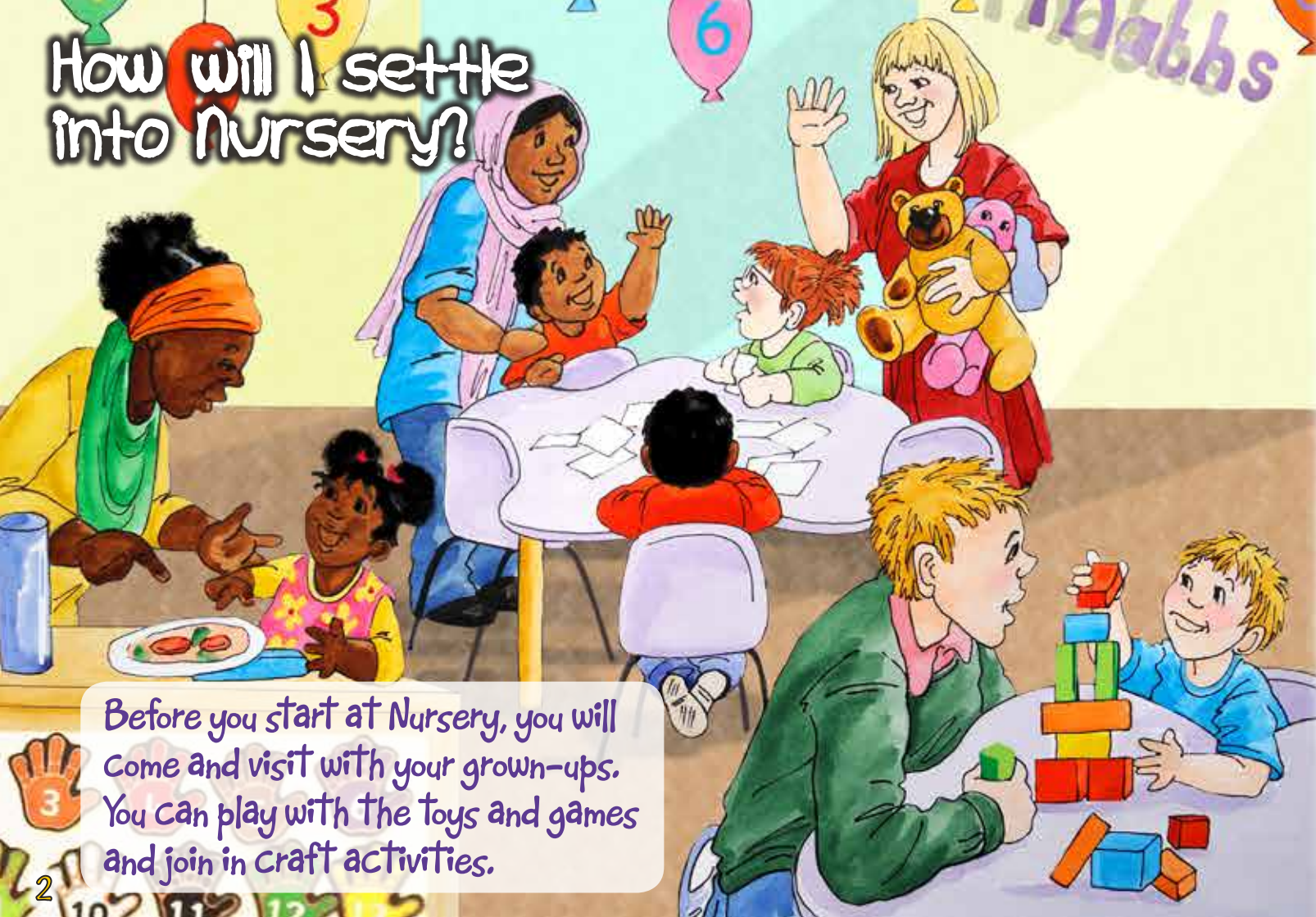




Mia, Dylan and Ahmed love

Craft



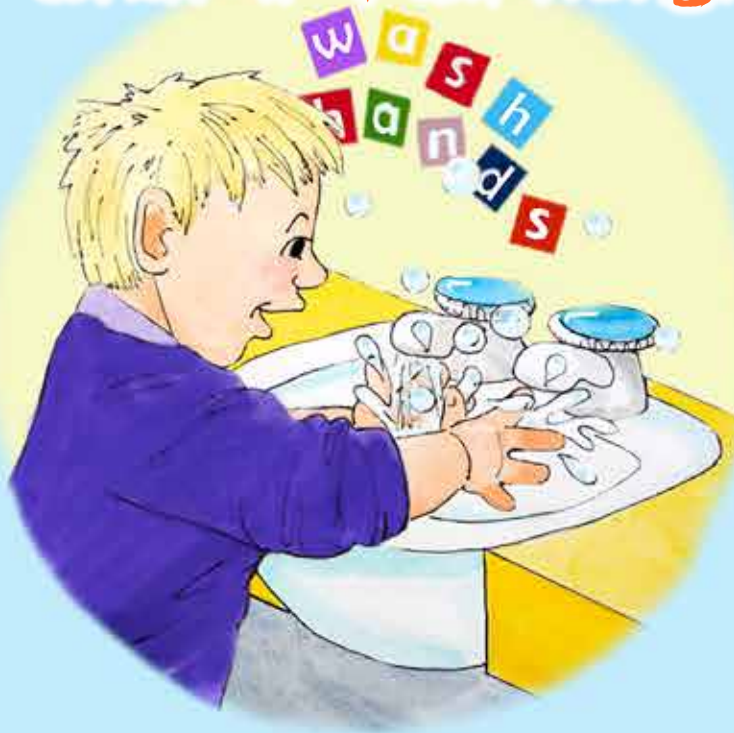
Reading books

What tomorrow brings

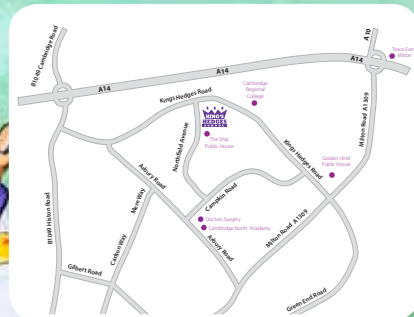
Mia is so excited about taking her reading book home.
